- Perform detailed equipment inspections during scheduled shutdowns
- Provide operational support to circuit and unit operations.
- Coordinate with maintenance group on driving operational needs for plant equipment.
- Integral role in small and large scale project development and commissioning

The successful candidate will be working a 5x2 schedule and will have the following qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in metallurgical, mineral processing, or chemical engineering
- Basic competency in programming languages
- Strong interpersonal skills and the ability to communicate effectively with operators and tradesmen
- Previous site experience in a Copper Porphyry deposit
- Demonstrated history of safe work habits

- Registered or able to register with EGBC
